

Legal 500 Ranks Selendy Gay Among Nation's Top Litigation Firms for Fourth Straight Year

Selendy Gay has been named one of the country's top litigation firms by Legal 500 for the fourth consecutive year. The firm's Securities Litigation, General Commercial Disputes, and Appellate practices—along with several individual attorneys—were recognized among the best in their fields.

Leaders in Securities Litigation

Legal 500 once again awarded the firm's Securities and Structured Finance practice, which has "amassed significant expertise in the financial services sector," for winning landmark victories that include recoveries in excess of 100 percent of principal and market losses.

The practice was praised for its work in complex financial structures, particularly noting a case in which they are "currently acting for classes of investors in multiple digital tokens and other crypto-assets against crypto asset exchanges."
