

Faith Gay Receives Lifetime Achievement Award from Corporate Counsel

Faith Gay, founding partner of Selendy Gay, has been chosen for a Lifetime Achievement Award by *Corporate Counsel* as part of its 2022 *Women, Influence & Power in Law Awards*. Each year, *Corporate Counsel* honors extraordinary leaders who have made a unique contribution to the legal profession—in shaping law and obtaining outsized results for their clients while expanding access to justice.

For more than 35 years, Faith has undertaken challenging cases to advance equality of opportunity, justice, and dignity for all. Most recently, she has represented the American Federation of Teachers in its successful fight to obtain legally mandated educational debt relief for public servants, and Capitol Hill Police Officers wounded while serving their country during the January 6th attacks.

In her commercial work, Faith has been lead counsel in over 40 trials and has successfully guided scores of Fortune 500 and international companies, special committees, non-governmental entities, and C-suite executives through multi-regulator investigations.

Faith is an ordained Presbyterian minister and serves on the Executive Committee of the Northwestern University School of Law Board of Trustees, and the Boards of the Public Theater, the Clark Foundation, Union Theological and the Campaign Legal Center, among others.
