Founding partners Faith Gay and Jennifer Selendy were recognized by *Forbes* as two of America's Top 200 Lawyers. The inaugural ranking is based on the publication's rigorous process of researching, evaluating, and rating thousands of candidates across the country. Professionals were selected for their stellar track records, reputation among peers and competitors, and leadership in the most consequential cases, deals, and legal developments.
