

Supreme Court — A Year in Review, 2020 Term

- Business Law and Civil Procedure (*Google LLC v. Oracle America Inc.*, *Ford Motor v. Montana*, *National Collegiate Athletic Association v. Alston*, *TransUnion LLC v. Ramirez*)
