On behalf of the American Association of University Professors (AAUP) and its Harvard chapter, Selendy Gay filed a [complaint and Temporary Restraining Order](#) to end the government's arbitrary and capricious demands that threaten academic independence and free speech.

Selendy Gay also authored an [amicus brief](#) on behalf of The Presidents' Alliance on Higher Education and Immigration, as well as 86 supporting organizations, in support of the AAUP's motion in *AAUP v. Rubio* for a preliminary injunction to halt large-scale arrests, detentions, and deportations of students and faculty.
